BHS Seniors,

The Berwick Area School District Board of Directors recently approved a motion to allow all seniors the option to bring their own device (BYOD) to school for instructional purposes. This is not a mandatory requirement but does provide the opportunity for you to utilize your own device. There are guidelines in place if you choose to bring your own device to school. Those guidelines are attached and must be read and agreed upon. Please sign, and have a parent/guardian sign, and return the attached guidelines to your homeroom teacher before bringing your device to school and before it is activated by the technology department. It is imperative that you return your district issued device within one month of your personal device being registered with the technology department.

You must first complete a BYOD application before bringing your device to the building. That application can be found on the District Website under the tab *Departments* and then from the drop down menu click *Technology* (https://www.berwicksd.org/domain/19). The Google Form is listed under the heading *Technology Web Resources* and the form is labeled *BYOD application*. Once you complete this form a help ticket will be generated and you will be notified by the technology department when your equipment is active. Please note your device will not be able to access the Wi-Fi until you receive this notification.

We hope the BYOD option supports your learning and alleviates concerns you may have in regards to technology!
